

Privacy Notice: DH Coir

Updated: 7th November 2022

This privacy notice tells you what to expect when DH Coir collects personal information about you when you take part in one of our consultations. DH Coir is committed to protecting your personal information. Whenever you provide such information we are legally obliged to use your information in line with all applicable laws concerning the protection of personal data, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

What information will we collect about you?

In general, we will collect the following information about you:

First name

Last name

Email address

DH Coir collects information about how you use our website and the device(s) you use to access it. This includes collecting unique online identifiers such as IP addresses, which are numbers that uniquely identify a specific computer or other network device on the internet. For more information, see our section on 'cookies'.

How will DH Coir use the information it collects about me?

The lawful justification for collecting and using your personal data is that it is for our legitimate interests and those of users are met responsibly when conducting business.

We will keep your information within DH Coir and our trusted third parties except where disclosure is required by law, for example to government bodies and law enforcement agencies. Your information is processed only in the UK and is not moved or transferred overseas.

How long will DH Coir keep my information?

The duration your data will be retained for is specified by the needs each individual person, data will not be retained for longer than is required and be securely destroyed.



What rights do I have over my personal data?

Under the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the right to:

Access your personal data

Rectification, erasure or restriction of information

Object to the processing

Data portability

Privacy & Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files which are stored on your computer when you visit certain web pages. At DH Coir we use cookies to understand how our sites are used which helps us to improve your overall online experience. Some of the cookies we use are necessary for some of our sites to work. The privacy of your information is important to us and so we want to keep you well informed about cookies. We shall continue to work on initiatives in relation to recent cookie legislation to ensure you have the best experience when visiting our websites.

The different types of cookies we use

DH Coir use the following categories of cookies on our websites:

Strictly necessary – These cookies are essential for certain features of our websites to work. These cookies do not record identifiable personal information and we do not need your consent to place these cookies on your device. Without these cookies some services you have asked for cannot be provided.

Performance – These cookies are used to collect anonymous information about how you use our websites. This information is used to help us improve our websites and understand how effective our adverts are. In some case we use trusted third parties to collect this information for us but they only use the information for the purposes explained. By using our websites, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device.

Functionality – These cookies are used to provide services or remember settings to enhance your visit for example text size or other preferences. The information these cookies collect is anonymous and does not enable us to track your browsing activity on other websites. By using our websites, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device.

Managing cookies

If you'd prefer to restrict, block or delete cookies from DH Coir you can use your browser to do this. Each browser is different, so check the 'Help' menu of your particular browser to learn how to change your cookie preferences. If you choose to disable all cookies we cannot guarantee the performance of our websites and some features may not work as expected.
